



This masterclass is aimed towards saxophonists aged 12 to 92: For professional musicians and for students as well as enthusiastic amateurs. The members of the quartet work with the participants in 'open' private instruction. Additionally, all participants make music every day in various ensembles, including a large saxophone orchestra!

Throughout the masterclass, the members of the quartet will work with the participants on a variety of topics including:

- interpretation of different musical works and genres
- solo and ensemble repertoire
- ideas on sound and tonal development
- overtone-technique and development of the high register
- embouchure, finger techniques, vibrato, intonation
- information and ideas on mouthpieces and reeds
- performance concepts and philosophies

If you are part of an existing saxophone ensemble, the lecturers may offer individual coaching for ensembles. Please ask for special rates if you intend to participate with your entire ensemble.
